Requirements for participation:

- Club must be a member of the national TKD Federation
- Competitor must have valid national licence.
- Medical certificate not older than a year (Kyorugi)
- Application and payment before closing date
- Declaration of consent for competitors under 18.

Competition Rules: Austrian Taekwondo Federation, WTF

Categories All age categories are based on year of birth and not age at the competition. Therefore it is their age on 31st December 2016.

Divisions (Poomsae and Kyorugi):

Novice		10th to 7th Kup
Advanced		6th to 3rd Kup
Expert		2nd Kup and up

POOMSAE

Expert (2nd Kup and up):

Competition Format:

All competitors perform the same Poomsae per round. Two poomsae will be drawn from the poomsae set list for every round, which have to be performed consecutively. Between the two performances the maximum break is one minute. In this break the competitor may consult their coach.

Drawing of the compulsory poomsae will take place on the day before the competition.

Depending on numbers of competitors there will be one, two or three rounds:

1st round

(11 competitors and up): The best 50% (at least 10 competitors) qualify for the next round, points cannot be kept.

2nd round

(6 to 10 competitors): The best 5 qualify for the final round, points cannot be kept.

3rd round

(Final round; 1 to 5 competitors)

Pairs: 2 Persons (m+f) **Teams:** 3 Persons (m+m+m/f+f+f)

Pairs/Teams can consist of persons from two adjacent age divisions (e.g. two pewees and one cadet) but must start in the higher division!

Advanced and Novice

Age divisions as in Expert

Competition Format:

Regardless of numbers of competitors, there is only one final round. Two Poomsae from the set list are to be chosen by the competitors and performed consecutively.

Novice: If competitors can only perform one Poomsae they may repeat the same Poomsae.

Grade	Set Poomsae
10 th to 7 th Kup (Novice)	Taeguk 1 to 8

Pairs and Teams:

The Set Poomsae is determined by the lowest belt grade in the team/pair.

Pairs/Teams may consist of competitors of different age divisions, the official age division will be the one of the eldest team/pair member.

Teams of any age division may be mixed teams (male/female).

Freestyle

Regardless of age, individuals male and female, pairs (mm, ff, mf) and teams (mmmff, mmfff) consisting of 5 competitors.

Duration corresponding to WTF rules. Music must be provided by the competitor (CD or USB).

Divisions may be pooled if there are not enough competitors in one division.

Protective gear:

Only WTF-recognized gear allowed. With the exception of the electronic body protectors (and e-Head Guard in some divisions, see below), all protective gear must be provided by the competitor (Forearm Guard, Shin Guard, Groin Guard, Gloves, Mouth Guard, Head Guard, Daedo-Sensor Socks).

Be advised: All competitions are being conducted with **Daedo EBP System**. Sensor socks must be provided by the competitors! **Electronic Head Gear in Experts Divisions of Senior, Junior and Cadet.**

General notes:

Gear: **Daedo EBP System!**
Groin guard is compulsory also for female competitors.
Belt color of competitors must be according to grade. White Dobok is compulsory, black V-Neck only for Dan grades.

Awards: Medals for places 1 to 3.
Only places that have been fought for are being recognized.

Coaches: For every competitor one coach (three coaches max per team) is granted free admission. Coaches (at least 18 years of age) must be named on the application form! Coaches and competitors can enter the competition area only with proper track suit/Dobok and indoor sports shoes.

Award ceremony: Only in Dobok or track suit – no street wear.

Protest: Will be announced at the coach meeting. Protest fee is 50 Euros.

Photo rights: With application you accept that SPORTUNION and the organizer may use all photos on their website, Facebook and similar media.

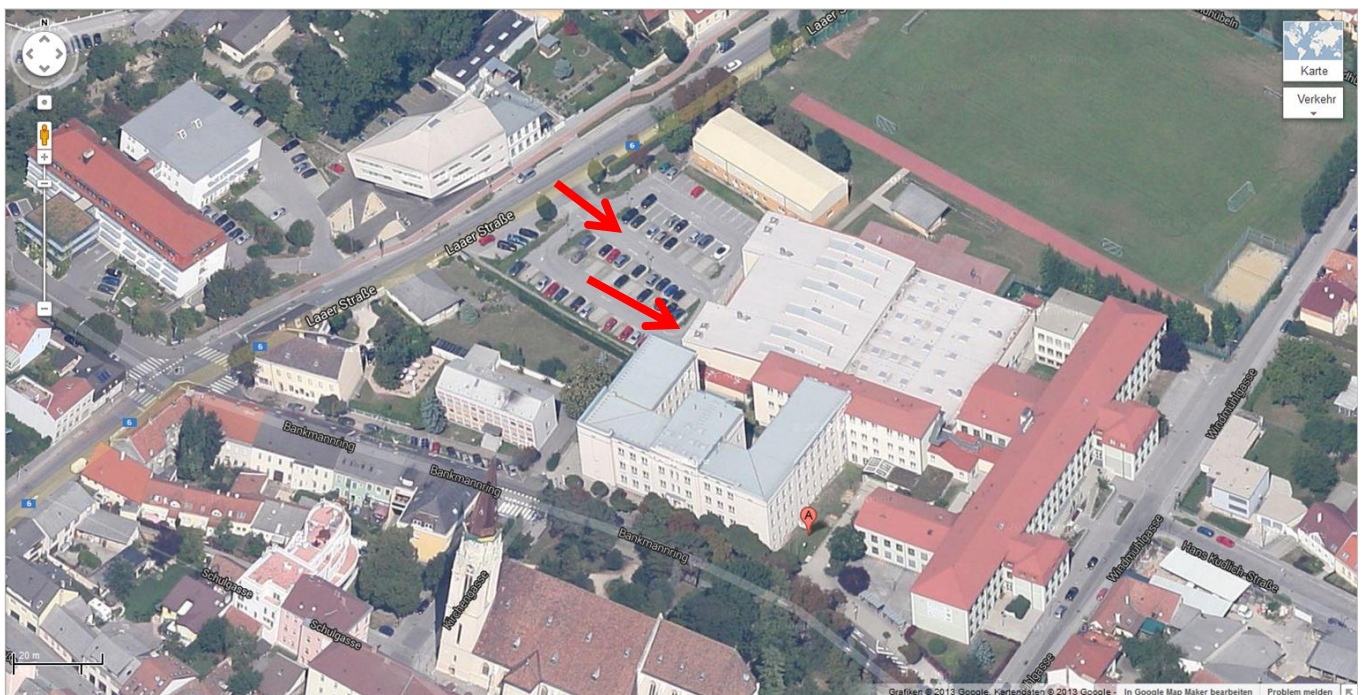
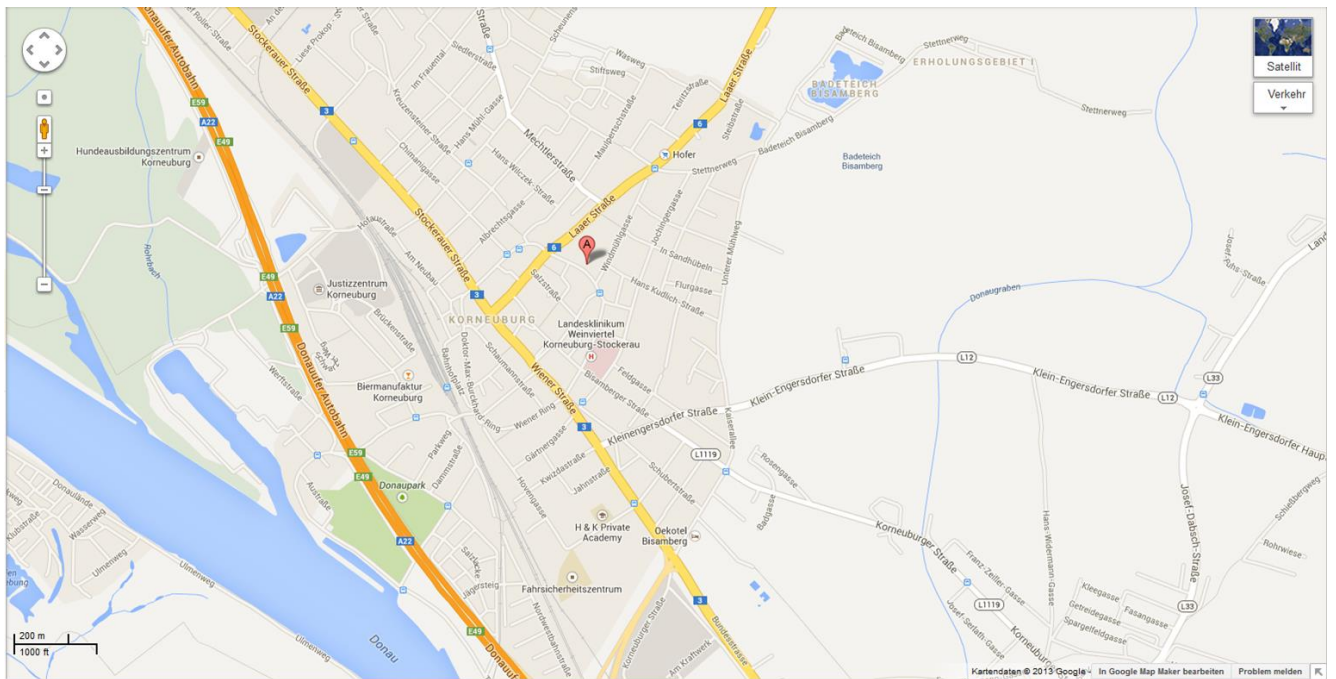

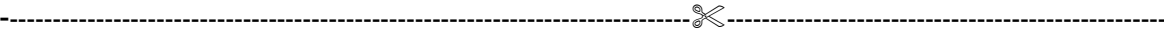
